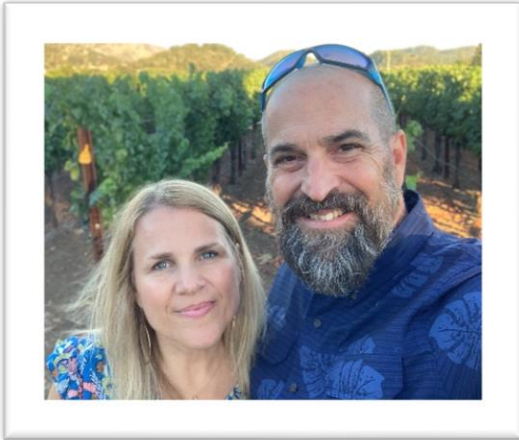

Three years ago, Mark and Amy took the step of faith and began a new project through Training Center Kompas (JV's partner organization in Slovakia) called University Treehouse, a life-on-life discipleship ministry where students live in their home with the goal of becoming deeply rooted and fruitful disciple-makers. Currently, Amy also leads Slovakia's summer internship program, they both

serve in their local church in a variety of ways, and they help lead Bratislava Spieva (Sings) Gospel, a musical community where the unchurched can encounter the living Christ.

Their work includes establishing new teams amongst unreached peoples, walking alongside current teams, and helping teams think through and navigate their team strategies while coordinating the various strategies amongst the teams they serve. They are coaches and mentors in the church planting process, providing pastoral care and assisting with any crisis that might arise. Beyond this, they continue to minister locally through long established relationships with local friends, and as they pursue new

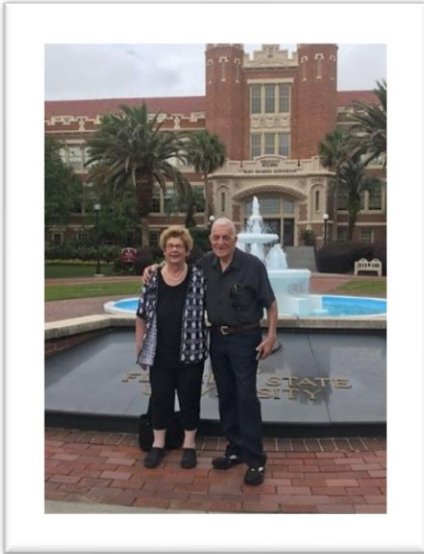
opportunities to be in relationship with neighbors in the capital, and thus ministering through prayer, sharing the good news, Bible study, community health ministry, and partnering with and encouraging the local church.

Ron and Judy Spaulding moved to Tallahassee, Florida in the spring of 2023, where they minister to international students at Florida State University through International Students, Inc. They will be using many of the skills they learned from ministering at the University of Nebraska in Lincoln for the past 17 years and at Colorado State University in Fort Collins for 10 years before that. They are excited to see God opening new doors of ministry in Florida. A local church just five blocks from campus provides rooms for Bible study and a large hall for dinners. There is already an ESL class that meets at the church on Tuesday evenings and a Sunday School class for internationals that meets on Sunday mornings. This provision is a great blessing as it is helping to “jump start” the ministry at FSU.

Prayer and Praise

STEVE & MELANIE GALEGOR



After serving in post-Communist Albania from 1995 to 2000, the Galegors moved to the NYC Metro Area where they have established some of the first Albanian churches in North America. Their work is a partnership of BILD International, the Charis Fellowship of Churches and numerous local churches and individuals who are committed to seeing a strong network of Albanian churches and ministries in their European homeland and in the Global Diaspora.

Steve continues to travel throughout the year back to Albania, Kosovo and other parts of Europe to equip leaders and networks of churches to build fully church-based discipleship and leadership training programs. They offer ordered learning in community for new believers all the way to accredited doctoral degrees. The goal is to strengthen these churches and entrust them and the ongoing mission to the next generation of well-trained leaders in the “Way of Christ and the Apostles.”

The desire of the Galegors, now living in Indiana, is to see a movement of first-generation Albanian immigrant churches and partner ministries in the Northeast and Midwest, wherever there are substantial Albanian communities. Many churches now exist since they began work in 2000 and have formed a “brotherhood” of churches across the U.S. and Canada. Their hope and prayer is to see the work of the gospel that began with the opening of Albania in 1991 make progress in the Albanian Diaspora in the U.S. and beyond.

Steve and Melanie have been married since 1990 and have three adult children: Jonah, Emma and Caleb.

- *Pray for the Albanian churches and believers in the NY Metro area to have boldness and vision for their unbelieving friends as the population equivalent of 10% of Albania lives in NY.*

DAVE & CONNIE PATTY



Since November 1993, Dave and Connie have lived in the Czech Republic where they began the work of Josiah Venture. Dave serves as president of this ministry, which reaches the next generation and disciples young leaders in 16 countries of Central and Eastern Europe. Connie leads the JV Prayer Room project. They have three adult children, two daughters-in-law, and six grandchildren.

In a typical year, the JV team shares the gospel with at least 25,000 young people, sees over 2,000 put their faith in Christ and trains 6,000 leaders. Their vision is for a movement of God among the youth of the region, one that finds its home in the local church and transforms society.

Currently only 1% of the young people in this region know Jesus Christ as Savior. Dave and Connie's desire is to see that change, resulting in churches full of young people who will be discipled into a new generation of leaders.

Prayer and Praise

- *Pray for leaders in JV—the Executive Team and the 16 country leaders—that God will give them wisdom to shepherd JV staff to evangelize, disciple and lead young people to living faith in Jesus across Central and Eastern Europe.*
- *Two-thirds of JV staff are national missionaries serving in their own countries. Pray for God to call even more nationals to effectively reach young people with the gospel. Pray that God will supply all of the resources needed to fulfill this calling.*
- *Pray for the new event center that we want to build at Malenovice, our training center in the Czech Republic: we have spent ten years applying for building permits and being denied because of neighbors opposed to the project. We are in another round of application with city and country officials; pray that God will grant us favor in this much-needed project to expand our capacity for training young leaders.*

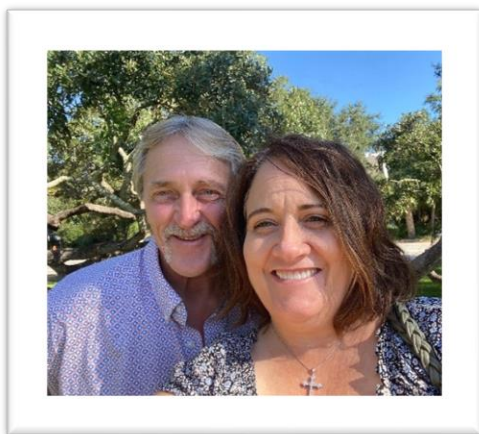
